**DIGITEC MEDICAL CORPORATION EXPANDS TO NEW FACILITY
*Noted After-Market Medical Equipment Company More than Triples in Size
with a Move Designed to Better Service Growing Customer Base***

LAWRENCEVILLE, GA, (May 15, 2007) – Digitec Medical Corporation, a leading after-market, medical equipment company focused exclusively on mammography (www.digitecmedical.com), today announced their move to a significantly larger facility. The company's new space, just a few miles from their current location, is 45,000 square feet. This more than triples the size of their headquarters, providing Digitec with new opportunities to serve more customers.

We're going to be able to do some things we've wanted to do for a while now."

Those plans include more refurbishing bays to meet the demand for mammography systems that pour in from all over the world. To match that, there will also be more QC bays to maintain the quality that Digitec is known for. "It was important to find a space that would allow us to maintain our strict quality standards," McGinty explained. "It had to be more than just four walls and a shipping dock." The new facility also gives Digitec a larger inventory space, and more training facilities, as well as expanded administrative offices. "We're very excited. We have a new home, a new logo, a new look – and it all comes during our 25th anniversary year. It's a great time to be working here."

The new address is 753 Winer Industrial Way, Suite F, Lawrenceville, GA 30045. Digitec plans to be settled into the new space by July 1.
